

Media Cabinet by Don Wenzlik

My daughter needed a cabinet to hide the wires under an 82" wall-mounted TV so I, with help from Dan Martin, built one in his shop and mounted it this March in her upstairs playroom.



It is 73.5" long, 40" high and 16" deep, spaced an inch out from the wall. It is painted the molding color.

Building material used: 3 sheets 3/4" plywood, 1 sheet 1/4" ply, and 20 bf poplar. This cabinet has some weight to it! Construction: biscuits, pocket holes and screws.

There are two surge protection power strips -- one visible and one behind a covered panel built into the top right door shelf. This is the connection point for the Wee, X box, CD player, and external speaker not yet attached.
