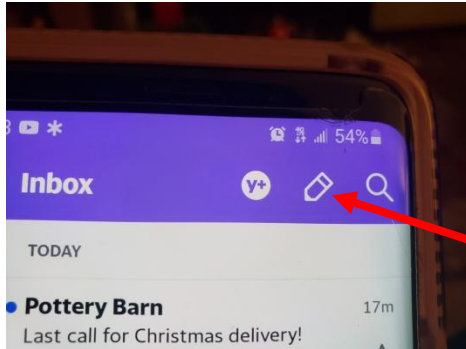


Using An Android Phone To Send Pictures

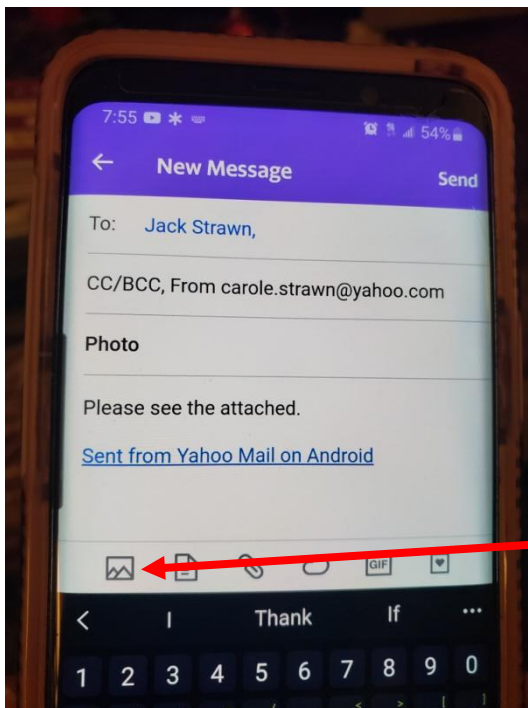
This example is Using Yahoo email on your Smart Phone. Though you may use a different email service than Yahoo.com and a different brand of cell phone, **look for similarities in words and symbols on your phone.**

These steps assume you have already taken the pictures using your cell phone that you wish to send.

Step #1. Enter your Yahoo email account.



Step #2. Click the pencil symbol to start a message.

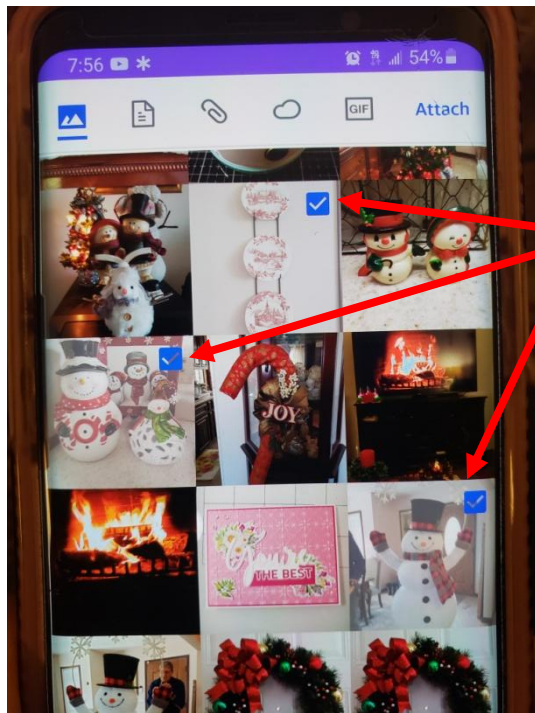


Step #3. To: type email address to whom will get pictures.

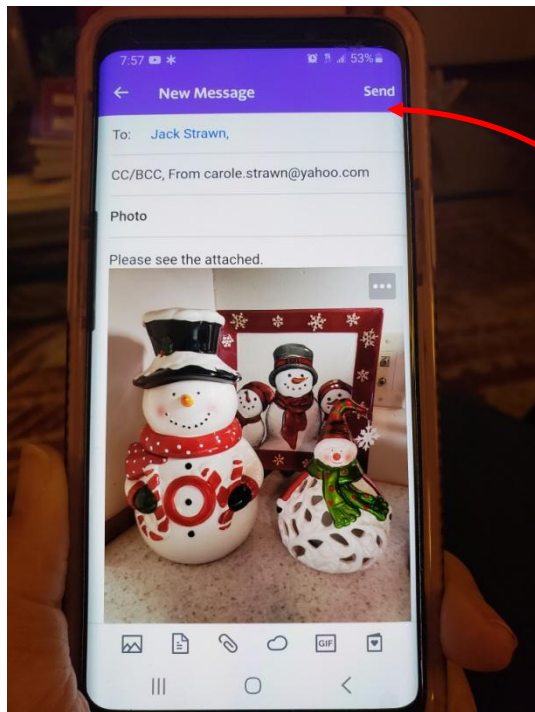
Step #4. Subject:
[examples: Photo (s) for newsletter, meeting, Member Showcase, photo ID].

Step #5. Click on picture of mountain range symbol.

Step #6. Tap the picture(s) you wish . A checkmark indicates the selected pictures. **NOTE: Usually limited of 2 or 3 pictures per email due to file size.**



NOTE: Picture(s) appear within message area rather than thumbnails at bottom of message. Receiving person can right click on the picture to download it to their Downloads Folder on their computer.

Step #7. After all pictures have entered the message. Tap **Send**.
